## BBM Baronial Review under way

This is an edited version of the announcement in May Pikestaff of the pending baronial review:

Attention all subjects of the Barony Beyond the Mountain:

As per East Kingdom Law, this announcement is intended to notify you of the impending Baronial Performance Review regarding your Baroness.

Residents of a barony under review will have 30 days from the announced starting date of the review to send written comments to the Crown regarding the performance of their

baron/baroness. In order to be considered, letters must be signed and contain contact information for the sender.

After reviewing all comments received, the Crown may take any action they deem necessary to correct deficiencies in the performance of the Baron/Baroness, up to and including removal from office. Within 15 days of the end of the commentary period, the Crown will contact the Baron/Baroness, Kingdom Seneschal, and the Baronial Seneschal to inform them of what actions will be taken, or if none will be.

The review period for the Barony Beyond the Mountain will begin on May 15, 2005 and will end on June 15, 2005.
